I am an astrophysicist, writer and speaker, recently retired senior research fellow of Konkoly Observatory (1974-2014) with a Ph. D (1984). My fields of research include solar physics, astrobiology, theoretical biology, biosemiotics and philosophy. I published 10 popular science books, more than 70 research papers and 400 popular articles and essays. I am the member of editorial boards of international scientific journals:

I had been the Director of the Collective Consciousness Group of the Club of Budapest founded by Ervin Laszlo. In 2011, I was invited to work as a visiting professor at the Chapman University, Orange, CA for half a year.
